The seven parishes of Diss, Roydon, Burston & Shimpling, Scole, Brome & Oakley, Stuston and Palgrave are working together to lead development of a Neighbourhood Plan for the Area covered by these parishes.

This Plan will be more complex than most, and it is probably the first to span four administrations - in our case it includes parts of South Norfolk and Mid Suffolk Districts and Norfolk and Suffolk Counties.

It is also ambitious in the scope and range of matters that we believe it should cover.

This is our First Public Consultation - where we ask **you** what you think of our suggestions.

The public consultation brochure will be delivered during February to about 6,800 addresses across the Area - homes and businesses - and will also be on-line on our website. The brochure includes a survey response form for you to complete as a household, a business or an interested organisation and a FREEPOST envelope is provided for you to return it. There is also an on-line version of the survey.
