**Local Projects** - Speed surveys have been completed on the Local Access Road. **Special Education Needs Funding** - On 23 April, Suffolk County Council's Cabinet agreed a financial investment of up to £45.6 million to support the development of local specialist provisions for children and young people with SEND. This includes two or three new special schools and approximately 30 specialist units attached to existing mainstream schools, a number of which aim to open in 2020
